Judging continues today for the 2007 Vintage Cellars National Wine Show of Australia. Entries in this year's show total 1298 from 208 wineries across Australia and New Zealand.

Chairman of judges, James Halliday will lead 9 Australian, 8 associate and 3 international judges into picking the top drops. The International judges this year are Neil Ellis from South Africa, Tim Atkin from the United Kingdom and Brent Marris from New Zealand.

With so many excellent quality wines, judging is going to be difficult but with 21 of the best palates in the industry, the task of selecting Australia's best wines will be made easier.
