Message from the Chair of Judges



Jim Chatto Chair of Judges

I would like to present the complete catalogue of results for the 2023 National Wine Show (NWS) of Australia. Which was held June 2023.

I would also like to acknowledge **David Bicknell** who has been the chair of judges at the NWS since 2018. David was devasted when he tested positive to Covid on the eve of the show. The roll of chair is a yearlong commitment leading up to the judging. Committee meetings, schedule and regulation refinements, sponsorship acquisition and assembling the judging team to name but a few of the responsibilities. 90% of the work is already done before the judging even starts. Being David's last show, it's really the culmination of some 5 years work towards reshaping Australia's pinnacle wine show.

Through his tenure David fostered a culture of collaborative excellence. I trust he can take some consolation in the fact the team he assembled did a

fantastic job in teasing out the best of the best from this year's entries.

Renewed eligibility criteria (only gold and silver medal winners from the eligible Australian wine shows) and a determination of bringing together the very best team of judges possible, resulted in a sharpened focus on the wines of great balance, detail, and real structure.

This year the team of judges tasted and deliberated their way through some 965 entries across 204 Australian producers, representing a 12% increase in entries and a 23% increase in exhibitors on the previous year. This speaks greatly of the health and industry relevance of the NWS.

The strike rate on medals was an impressive 78%, and 11% on golds. No doubt helped by the forementioned tighter eligibility rules.

The 20 major trophies were shared by no less than 14 producers across some 9 growing regions from all the key wine producing states, from small, medium and large producers alike. This incredible spread attests greatly to the breadth & depth of quality winemaking across Australia today.

Highlights – of many, but focusing on the strongest sections:

RIESLING

Riesling really shone, with some lovely expressive wines of great length & purity, really impressing the judges. Evidenced by the 79% medal strike rate, including a staggering 15% golds, shared across 5 growing regions. This gets even more impressive in Class 8 (2021 & older Riesling) Where 85% of the wines entered were awarded medals, including 8 (25%) gold medals! Riesling is the oft forgotten little sibling of Australian white wine, with many wonderful takes on style and place, making it a great option for so many occasions. A superb example from a tiny producer in Tasmania was only just edged out for the Best White Wine of Show in a very tight taste off.

SEMILLON

Another less sung stalwart of Australian wine also performed extremely well with 7 gold medals being awarded to Semillon, across only 38 entries -an impressive 18% strike rate. The spread of golds across 10 vintages, testifying to Semillons remarkable ability to age well yet provide great drinking young. Best Semillon went to a superb 4yo Semillon, still with years ahead of it.

CHARDONNAY

A variety that excels right across the country, under many varied growing conditions. Chardonnay from the 2021, 2020 and 2019 vintages did not disappoint, with some great examples out of Beechworth, Mornington, Yarra Valley, Tasmania,



Adelaide Hills and Margaret River all vying for the top awards. The strength of the 2021 vintage proven with 9 golds and 18 Silver medals representing a 12% and 24% strike rate respectively. A wonderfully poised 2021 Chardonnay taking out the Len Evans Trophy for best White Wine of Show.

PINOT NOIR

Pinot Noir from the 2021 vintage, really captivated the judges. Evidenced by 6 gold medals being awarded across only 36 entries. An amazing strike rate of nearly 17%. Heralding a coming of age for Australian Pinot, just as the matrix of site, clone, vine age and handling are starting to positively overlap. The key Pinot states of Tasmania & Victoria lead the charge, with the top two wines being superb examples from Tasmania and the Yarra Valley.

SHIRAZ

The largest section of the show with some 196 entries. Results for Shiraz were strong, with the judges awarding 17 Golds from no less than 11 regions, across a broad range of styles. Demonstrating the diversity, and adaptability, of our single most planted variety. The real star was the 2021 vintage, where 84% of the wines entered medalled and an impressive 8 golds and 20 Silvers were awarded out of 67 entries. The Prime Ministers Trophy for Best Red of Show was awarded to a pitch perfect rendition of cool climate Shiraz from 2021.

RED VARIETALS

A surprise this year was the Red Varietal class being the second biggest of the show. These newer (to Australia) varieties are fast being embraced by the industry and consumers alike. Testament to their suitability to our largely hot and arid climate. The judges found some exciting examples of Tempranillo, Montepulciano, Sangiovese, Aglianico, Barbera and Saperavi. Though only 3 golds in this class, it generated great discussion and excitement about the future potential with increased experience and vine age. The overall winner a variety with a much longer standing in Australia.

On behalf of the RNCAS, the Wine Show Committee and the judging team, I would like to thank all the exhibitors for supporting the National Wine Show of Australia. I look forward to seeing how these results contribute to your future success and the success of great Australian wine.

Judges



Jim Chatto Chair of Judges

Jim Chatto is winemaker and owner of Chatto Wines in Tasmania's Huon Valley. In 2009 Jim was named 'Hunter Valley Winemaker of the Year', and in 2019 was named Gourmet Traveller 'Winemaker of the Year'. A Len Evans Tutorial scholar, and senior wine show judge with over 25 years of judging experience. Including Chair of Judges at the National Wine Show of Australia (2014-2017) Hunter Valley Wine Show (2012-2014) McLaren Vale Wine show (2014-2016) and the Royal Queensland Wine Show (2019-2021).



Glenn Barry Panel Chair

Many years ago, Glenn swapped a lab coat for blood, sweat and grapes.

He was good at science, but not a fan of typical science-y jobs. Unimpressed with the thought of spending his life in a lab coat, Glenn was seduced by the blend of science and craftsmanship of winemaking. He packed his bags and moved from Brissie to Wagga Wagga to validate his feelings with a qualification. Then it was game on!

"I got my first vintage gig in the Clare Valley in '98 and quickly realised that this was the life for me. Lots of hard work, late nights and very dirty hands but to have something tangible, a bottle of wine, that people could enjoy at the end of it all was so damn satisfying!!"

Glenn's winemaking career reads like a textbook to the craft.

He soon took off overseas and worked vintages in big wineries in Italy, the US and Canada, as well as here in Australia. When he tired of years sleeping on other folks' couches, he took a job at Hardy's Tintara Winery in McLaren Vale.

Not afraid of the hard yards, Glenn worked his way up to Senior Winemaker and Site Manager. He won

numerous gold medals at wine shows, like Best White and Best Red Wines at the Royal Adelaide Wineshow in 2007.

Then in 2011, like a prodigal son, he moved back to where it all began — Clare Valley. This time as Chief Winemaker of the illustrious Knappstein brand, where he promptly took out Best Wine in South Australia in 2012 for his Riesling. And the wine show judging offers started rolling in.

He knew it was coming — the urge to get out and do his own thing. So Glenn left his stable 'big wine' role and quietly launched a little winery called Tonic. "I always try to make wines that are fun to drink with a little bit of interest. I had a note on my office computer for 15 years that simply said IS IT A GOOD DRINK? And that's what I try to do when making wines, make something that is simply delicious."



Rob Diletti Panel Chair

Robert Diletti has been part of Castle Rock Estate since its inception in 1981. He can still remember helping plant the first vines as a six year old in 1983. Many a school holiday and weekend was spent helping his parents on the vineyard.

In 1995 he enrolled in the Charles Sturt University winemaking course, graduating in 1998. After finishing his studies Rob worked at Mountadam and Alkoomi, completed a vintage in Alsace, France and then returned to Castle Rock Estate to design and build the winery with his family.

Rob has been Chief Judge of the Perth Royal Wine Show, as well as Panel Chair and Judge at numerous other capital city, state and regional wine shows.

As well as receiving many awards for his wines, Rob also has achieved many personal accolades including being a finalist in Gourmet Traveller Winemaker of the Year Awards in 2012 and 2019 and was the inaugural Wine Maker of the Year in James Halliday's 2015 Wine Companion!



Jeremy Dineen Panel Chair

With over 20 years experience in wineries, vineyards, brand development, sales, marketing and wine business management, Jeremy has extensive knowledge of winery design and operations, vineyard management, product development, packaging, distribution, sales and business optimisation.

Prior to starting Vintegrity Consulting, Jeremy was Chief Winemaker and General Manager at Josef Chromy Wines in the Tamar Valley, where he built and developed one of the most successful integrated wine, hospitality and tourism businesses in Tasmania. Jeremy had already developed an intimate knowledge of Tasmanian viticulture, and the complexities associated with contract winemaking, during five vintages at Hood Wines in southern Tasmania with as many as 38 vineyards under his care.

With a strong technical background, and winemaking experience across multiple regions, Jeremy has a track record that includes high quality wines, multiple awards, sales growth and, importantly, profitability.

Jeremy has a long history of industry involvement and contribution, including past terms as a Director of Wine Tasmania, Chairman of Vineyards Association of Tasmania Technical Committee, member of the organising committee for the International Cool Climate Wine Symposium, member of both organising and program committees for the Australian Wine Industry Technical Conference and founder of the Effervescence Sparkling Wine Festival, among others.

In addition to winemaking and wine business (including his own brands Haddow + Dineen and Broad Arrow Wines), Jeremy is an experienced wine show judge with terms as Panel Chair and Chairman of Show at regional and capital city wine shows.



Tom Carson
Panel Chair

Yabby Lake General Manager and Chief Winemaker, Tom Carson also holds several wine judging roles including his current post as Chairman of the Royal Melbourne Wine Awards. Previously, Tom was the youngest Chairman to preside at The National Wine Show in Canberra, and over the years he has judged at a number of capital city and regional shows, and sat on the Qantas Wine Panel from 2004 until 2015.

Tom graduated from Oenology at Roseworthy Agricultural College in 1991. His first vintages as a winemaker followed at Tim Knappstein in the Clare Valley (1991 & 92) and it was here that Tom discovered the potential for pinot noir in Australia, working with the first two vintages of Lenswood Vineyards Pinot Noir. Tom first travelled to Burgundy in 1992 and in between two consecutive vintages, returned to Australia as assistant winemaker to James Halliday at Coldstream Hills (1993 & 94).

In 1996, Tom took up the opportunity to realise the vision of the Rathbone family, new owners of Yering Station in the Yarra Valley. During his 12 years at the helm, the winery met with significant international acclaim including 'International Winemaker of the Year' at the 2004 International Wine and Spirit Competition in London. During this period, Tom returned to France for several vintages - Burgundy (2000 at Domaine Bernard Moreau in Chassagne Montrachet) and Champagne (1996 at Champagne Devaux, Bar-sur-Seine & 2002 - Les Gras and Haas, Chouilly on the Cote de Blanc). In 2002, Tom was named the Dux of the Len Evans Tutorial which marked the beginning of his wine judging career.

Tom joined Yabby Lake in 2008 and his vision for the direction and potential of Yabby Lake Vineyard and Heathcote Estate has seen some exciting recognition in recent times.



Matt Harrop Judge

Matt Harrop is the winemaker at Curly Flat Vineyards in the Macedon Ranges, Victoria. He is the current chairman of judges at the Royal Melbourne Wine Awards. Matt has previously judged at the Brisbane and Sydney wine shows, as well as numerous regional shows. He lives in the Macedon Ranges on a farm with his family, pets, a flock of sheep and a small vineyard.



Stuart Hordern Judge

Stuart is Senior Winemaker at Brokenwood Wines in the Hunter Valley, where he has worked since 2009. Stuart holds a Bachelor in Oenology from the University of Adelaide. Stuart has judged at numerous regional and national wine shows around Australia and is a past DUX of the Len Evans Tutorial. Stuart is the current President of the Hunter Valley Wine and Tourism Association.



Mark O'Callaghan Judge

Mark O'Callaghan is the Managing Director of Wine Network Consulting and works with many different clients across Australia and internationally. The advisory work covers a diverse range of topics from winemaking and vineyard advice to winery design and upgrades, due diligence assessments, recruitment and general business improvement.

Before joining WNC, Mark spent many years as a winemaker with Accolade Wines at various locations around Australia, plus time in Austria and Sicily. He is on the management committee for the Royal Melbourne Wine Awards and Victorian Pinot Noir Workshop, a regular wine show judge, occasional author and lecturer and former president of Wine Yarra Valley. He is also the former committee chair for the Yarra Valley Wine Show, James Halliday Chardonnay Challenge and a scholar at the 2007 Len Evans Tutorial.



Toby Barlow Judge

Toby Barlow joined Treasury Wine Estates in August 2019. Previously Toby has worked as Mitchelton Winemaker (2000-2007), St Hallett Senior winemaker (2007 -2012) and Senior Winemaker/ Wineries Director for the Lion Wine Group and Fine Wine Partners from April 2012 to January 2017 when the group was purchased by Accolade Wines. Toby's role then grew to encompass the Accolade premium wineries including such wineries as Grant Burge,

Petaluma, Stonier, Bay of Fires, Knappstein, Hardy's Tintara and Houghton. Aside from these roles Toby worked vintages in a number of different regions including Brown Brothers (NE Victoria), Argyle (USA), Matua (NZ), Monarch (Hunter Valley), Cave de Tain l'Hermitage (France) and Merum Priorati in Priorat, Spain.

Toby holds a Bachelor of Arts (Philosophy major) and a Graduate Diploma in Oenology. Toby was Dux of the (AWRI) Advanced Wine Assessment Course, runner up at the Len Evans Tutorial in 2013 and has extensive wine show judging experience over the last fifteen years at both capital city and regional shows. Toby is one of the founding members of the Barossa Grounds Committee launched in 2008 to investigate subregional expression of Shiraz within the Barossa.



Chris Tyrrell Judge

Chris Tyrrell is the fifth generation of the Tyrrell family winemaking dynasty, alongside his sister Jane and brother John.

Chris began his winery apprenticeship in 2001 at age 18, the first vintage after the passing of his grandfather and Australian winemaking legend Murray Tyrrell.

From then on Chris has worked with his family's wine company. In between vintages he worked in the sales and marketing department until the end of 2005 when he returned to work full time in the winery.

From 2006 through 2014 Chris was the Assistant Winemaker working with two of the great modern day Hunter Valley winemakers, Chief Winemaker Andrew Spinaze and Red Winemaker Mark Richardson.

In late 2014 Chris was promoted to the role of Chief Operating Officer, overseeing all facets of production at the Hunter Valley winery and vineyard.

In recent years Chris, and the rest of the Tyrrell's winemaking team, have focused heavily on improving, and in some cases reinventing their classic regional styles and single vineyard sites. Specifically the flagship Semillon and Shiraz wines from some of the world's oldest vineyards.

Chris is also an active judge in the Australian wine show circuit and has also recently completed the Winemakers' Federation of Australia "Future Leaders" Program which focuses on developing the

next generation of Australian wine industry leaders. He also current serves on the Board of the Hunter Valley Wine & Tourism Association as a Director.

In May 2012, Chris was named "Rising Star" at the Hunter Valley Wine Industry Association Legends Awards - an award which recognises young talent in the Hunter Valley.

In November 2012 Chris was a scholar at the Len Evans Tutorial, what is said to be the "most exclusive wine school in the world".

Now 40, Chris will continue to ensure that the family winemaking legend continues for one of the world's great wine families.



Kate Laurie Iudge

Clocking up over 20 years as the sole wine maker for two small wineries, Kate has been hands on in all facets of grape and wine production. Stone Bridge Estate was created in partnership with her parents, and Deviation Road with her husband, which gave her

the freedom to create the wine styles and have input on the direction for each winery from the beginning – in particular with the sparkling wine range. Having lived and studied winemaking in Champagne out of high school, her passion was quickly focused on mastering the art of creating quality sparkling wines within their own regional context. Kate is passionate about sharing her love of all things sparkling, hosting masterclasses at the cellar door, and recently as ambassador for Tasting Australia.



Cath Oates

Cath studied business/viticulture at Curtin University followed by oenology at University of Adelaide. Her international career included Group Winemaker at Mud House Wine Group (NZ), Chief Winemaker at Plantagenet Estate and flying winemaker gigs in Italy and USA. She left sensible employment in 2015 to focus on making Oates Ends, wines from the intergenerational family farming property in Margaret River and run her consulting business.

Anna Pooley Judge

Anna grew up in the Coal River Valley, Tasmania and moved away to study winemaking in Adelaide. After university she worked for 10 years for Treasury Wine Estates. In this time she worked with brands such as Wolf Blass, Penfolds, and the Tasmanian brand Heemskerk.

She travelled and completed many vintages overseas including in Austria and Italy.

In 2010 Anna was awarded the Australian Young Winemaker of the Year and in 2018 was a Finalist for the Gourmet Traveller Winemaker of the Year. Anna is a Len Evans Tutorial scholar and has judged at many of the capital city and regional wine shows.

Anna moved back to Tasmania in 2012 with her family where they set up the winery for her family label Pooley Wines. The first time in 30 years that the wines have been made in house. Since then Anna and her husband have achieved multiple accolades for the wines and are in the process of converting the family's two vineyards to organic management.



Adam Walls

It was through working in bars and developing a healthy interest in all things distilled that Adam stumbled across the world of wine. This stumble morphed into 10 years of working with wine in hotels, bars and restaurants across Australia and the UK, followed up by stints in cellar doors in the Hunter Valley. Adam is a wine buyer for Wine Selectors and is the co-chair of their tasting panel. Adam pens a column for Selector magazine, host's events around the country and is a regular of Channel 10's My Market Kitchen. He holds the WSET Diploma in Wine & Spirits; is a graduate of the AWRI AWAC

course and was the DUX of the 2019 Len Evans Tutorial. He has been an active wine show judge for the past 8 years.



Sam Connew Judge

When Samantha finished a double degree in law and arts, making wine wasn't on the cards. But on an overseas trip she had an epiphany and returned to New Zealand to study winemaking. She worked in high-profile jobs, won a prestigious international award and swore she'd never start her own label. Then passion and curiosity got the better of her and she began making tiny amounts of Tasmanian wine. The business took off and now Samantha crafts handpicked, wild-fermented wines from her own vineyard.

After completing post-graduate studies in winemaking and viticulture in her home country of New Zealand, Samantha worked her first vintage in Oregon in the US and became hooked on Pinot Noir. She built her reputation as one of Australia's best winemakers during a decade at McLaren Vale's renowned Wirra Wirra, and in 2007 was named the International Red Winemaker of the Year at the International Wine Challenge in London.

It was while working in the Hunter Valley in wine research and development that she quietly started her own label, Stargazer, in 2013 (and soon after became the first female chair of judges at the Sydney Wine Show). The name is a nod to her origins and a tribute to explorer Abel Tasman, the first European to sight Tasmania and then New Zealand's South Island, navigating by the stars.

Samantha's business grew faster than expected, and a few years later she moved to Tasmania and bought a vineyard. She then got to work planting new vines, especially Riesling, Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. In 2019, her vineyard was named Tasmania Vineyard of the Year and Up and Coming Vineyard of the Year by the Royal Agricultural Society of Tasmania.

Samantha takes a light-touch approach in the winery, handcrafting wines renowned for their purity and authenticity.

"I see myself as a guardian, getting the fruit into the bottle with a minimal amount of interference, and capturing the vineyard in that particular season," she says.



Julian Langworthy Judge

Growing up in Western Australia's pristine Margaret River, with a father who studied pests in vineyards for the Agricultural Protection Board, Julian was fascinated by wine from a young age. After a brief dalliance with marine biology, he studied winemaking ("It seemed like it'd be fairer on the fish," he jokes), then worked in France and Canada as well as Australia's Clare Valley, Barossa Valley and Coonawarra regions.

In 2011, Julian returned to his hometown to join the Fogarty Wine Group. As Chief Winemaker he's responsible for the Group's five brands and a team of 12 winemakers, with a special focus on Deep Woods Estate, one of the region's most awarded wineries. Cabernet Sauvignon is the crown jewel – and Julian's favourite variety.


"My life in wine has been a life in Cabernet," he says. "What I really want to achieve is to make the world's best Cabernet, and in Margaret River I'm 100% certain that we can do that."

Julian is regarded as one of the most talented winemakers in Australia with awards such as James Halliday's Winemaker of the Year, a Jimmy Watson Trophy winner, Ray Jordan's Winemaker of the Year, and a Wine Society Young Winemaker of the Year nominee. His impressive career has included vintages in France and Canada, as well as senior winemaking roles in the Barossa Valley, Clare Valley and Coonawarra.

Passionate about producing regionally distinctive wines, Julian joined the Deep Woods team in 2011. Under his leadership, the winemaking team has continued to refine and explore the Deep Woods style, culminating in more than 60 trophies and 200 gold medals awarded across major national and international wine shows.

His successes haven't taken away his excitement for winemaking and drive to keep exploring and improving.

"Every season is different and every season you've got a new opportunity to make the best wine you could ever make," says Julian. "That's probably one of the great joys of winemaking."

JAMES HALLIDAY AM

Nobody has had more of an impact on Australian winemaking than James Halliday AM.

Australia's most respected wine critic, wine writer, vigneron and senior wine competition judge has been the driving force behind Australia's global recognition as a nation to be reckoned with when it comes to producing outstanding wines.

James' breadth of knowledge, which he has passed on through more than 70 books on wine including his world-famous *Halliday Wine Companion*, is staggering.

His mentorship, support and guidance of Australian winemakers, wine judges and wine writers cannot be underestimated in terms of its influence in shaping a vibrant and exciting industry that today produces some of the world's best wines, and is populated by dedicated, passionate people who are always striving for the best.

The National Wine Show of Australia is honoured to have had James Halliday's patronage for more than 40 years.

In 1981 James joined the show as a judge, under the chairmanship of BJ Barry and with a committee that included the esteemed likes of Peter Lehmann, Max Lake and James' great mate, Len Evans. James has served as Chair of Judges several times in the show's 48-year history.



In 1995 James joined the show's advisory panel and, to our eternal gratitude, he has never left.

James's advisory panel stewardship has transformed the show from its humble beginnings in 1975 into what is now widely recognised as the nation's most important wine awards, one of few in the world whose federated model means only wines that have already won gold or silver medals in qualifying

regional and city shows make it to the judging table.

The rigour and governance behind the National Wine Show ensures we attract not only the very best wines in Australia each year, but the very best judges. Having James Halliday's name so closely associated with our show has helped in no small measure.

It is impossible to put a value on James' contribution to the National Wine Show of Australia, and to the Australian wine industry as a whole. Tonight, however, we would like to take the opportunity to honour James's outstanding contribution in support of the National Wine Show of Australia.

Another outstanding year for the National Wine Show (NWS) of Australia. Entries, new exhibitors, and sponsorship were all up and national media coverage of the Show was extensive. Our ability to grow and execute the highest quality wine show is largely a function of the support we are afforded by the Australian wine industry and our amazing sponsors led by the Endeavour Group. I would like to thank all of them for their continued support which is critical to grow the NWS both nationally and internationally.

In accordance with ASVO guidelines the National Wine Show Committee undertakes targeted compliance audits of exhibitors entering the NWS Show. In 2023 exhibitors from Tasmania were audited and no discrepancies or non-compliance with entry regulations were identified. I would like to thank those exhibitors for their positive engagement with the audit process. I was delighted to see some secure a trophy at the 2023 NWS.

This year marks the last year of David Bicknell's threeyear tenure as Chair of Judges which commenced in 2018! Despite being punctuated by the cancellation of the 2020 Show due to covid David has been instrumental in helping re-position the National Wine Show to firmly cement it at the pinnacle of what is an outstanding Australian Show judging system. Some of the initiatives David has championed include strengthening wine qualifying requirements through removing bronze medals as a means of accessing the Show; tightening the criteria for all wine shows seeking to be accredited NWS qualifying; introducing the concept of mentor judges and recognizing the evolution of the Australian wine industry through changes such as including a standalone Grenache class. It was in some way ironic, and certainly disappointing, that David was struck down by Covid literally on the eve of judging the 2023 Show. Very much reflecting the immeasurable depth of judging talent the NWS attracts Jim Chatto, a former NWS Chair, was pulled from the ranks to assume the 2023 Chair of Judges role which he did brilliantly. My sincere thanks to David for his leadership and effort

during his tenure as Chair of Judges and to Jim for jumping in with only hours notice to ensure the 2023 NWS was a huge success.

I would also like to extend my personal thanks to outstanding individuals who are retiring from the NWS. Michele Norris has been the backbone of the NWS Committee commencing as a steward with the NWS in 2000 and assuming the role of Deputy Committee Chair in 2010. Her immense knowledge, experience and energy have been pivotal to the success of the NWS. She will be missed by all, but will no doubt remain a friend and active supporter of the Australian wine industry. Thank you, Michele.

John "Chippy" Payne will also be standing down in 2023 after 45 years!!!! as a NWS steward. He has always provided those around him with the support and wisdom he has gleaned during his 45 years. His calm, friendly manner was a highlight. To ensure the family name is not lost to the NWS Chippy passes the baton to his son Adam who is an integral part of the NWS Steward team. Thank you, Chippy.

Finally, I would like to thank my Deputy Chair, Deanna Riddell and Committee colleagues, Stewards, support team and volunteers who have assisted in delivering an outstanding 2023 Show. The 2024 Show promises to be even better!!!


